On behalf of the World Organization for Peace and for the benefit of your people and all peoples of the world, we ask that you help us find a way to open a Peace Dialogue in the face of a war that can lead to unpredictable results for everyone.

Peaceful Dialogue we believe is the best way to bring calm to your population and recover the General Welfare and be able to rebuild from the material damage left by war. A cessation of hostilities will give the opportunity to move forward to build that fixed ideal of Peace and Prosperity.

We hope with great interest that your nation will find the desired peace.
